Sew Crazy Quilt Guild Biennial Quilt Show 2019

The Sew Crazy Quilt Guild of Leesville, Louisiana will be presenting their 5th biennial Quilt Show in a new location this year during May Fest. They will be at the Family Worship Center Gym at 601 East Mechanic Street. Friday, May 3rd from 10:00am to 5:00pm and Saturday, May 4th from 10:00am to 4:00pm. Admission tickets for the Quilt Show will be \$3.00 for adults and children under 12 will be free. Tickets are available for the "Opportunity Quilt" for \$1.00 for one ticket or \$5.00 for six tickets. The "Opportunity Quilt" was pieced and quilted by the members with the Oriental fabric being donated by Granada Bourg, also a member. The intricate pattern on the quilt is called the Pineapple pattern. The drawing for the quilt will be at 4:00pm Saturday afternoon. All quilts presented in the show will be made by members only.

Approximately 75 to 100 quilts and handmade items will be on display in the Quilt Show. Ten categories of quilts will be judged and displayed to view with ribbons attached. The Show will have some "un-judged" quilts displayed in a separate area. There will be some quilts for sale. Door prizes will be given during the two days of the show. Winners have to be present to receive the prize. There will also be a silent auction for the "mini" quilts made by the members. A "Country Store" will be open to buy handmade items that were donated by the Guild members. Numerous vendors are anticipated being there also.

A little history about "Sew Crazy Quilt Guild". This guild was established around 1991. The Guild has grown to 44 members as of today. Every year the Sew Crazy Quilt Guild sets up a booth during the Vernon Parish Fair with some of the projects (not only quilts) that they have been working on throughout the year. The Sew Crazy Quilt Guild working on two specific charity projects every year. They sewed and donated over 267 pillowcases to the Lions Crippled Children's Camp last May and donated 168 quilts to CASA in December.
