COUNT 1: IN THAT HE DID ON OR ABOUT THE 1ST DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 2015 THROUGH THE 31ST DAY OF AUGUST, 2017, intentionally perform his duties, as a Chief of Police, Ball, Louisiana, in an unlawful manner by acting in violation of La. R.S. 14:67, with the misappropriating or taking, with an intent to deprive permanently, a thing of value over \$1,000, to-wit: monies belonging to another, without consent to the

misappropriation or taking, and by means of fraudulent conduct, practices, or representations.

COUNT 2: IN THAT HE DID ON OR ABOUT AND BETWEEN THE 1ST DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 2015, AND THE 31ST DAY OF AUGUST, 2017, knowingly and intentionally use the authority of his office or position, directly or indirectly, to compel or coerce any person to provide him with anything of apparent present or prospective value; in violation of R.S. 14:134.3;

COUNT 3: IN THAT HE DID ON OR ABOUT AND BETWEEN THE 1ST DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 2015 AND THE 31ST DAY OF AUGUST, 2017, knowingly and intentionally remove, mutilate, destroy, alter, falsify, or conceal any record, document, or other thing, filed or deposited, by authority of law, in any public office or with any public officer, in violation of R.S. 14:132(A);

COUNT 4: IN THAT HE DID ON OR ABOUT AND BETWEEN THE 1ST DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 2015, AND THE 31ST DAY OF AUGUST, 2017, file or deposit for record, to any public office or with any public official, any document containing a false statement or false representation of a material fact, in violation of R.S. 14:133.

COUNT 5: IN THAT HE DID ON OR ABOUT AND BETWEEN THE 1ST DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 2015, AND THE 31ST DAY OF AUGUST, 2017, did knowingly receive any payment or compensation or permitted his name to be carried on any employment list or payroll for any payment or compensation from the state, for services not actually rendered by himself, and/or for services grossly inadequate for the payment or compensation received or to be received according to such employment list or payroll, in violation of R.S. 14:133.
