QUESTION: Shall the Board of Trustees of School District No. 232, Gooding County, State of Idaho, be authorized and empowered to levy a Supplemental Levy in the amount of six hundred thousand and no/dollars (\$600,000.00) per year for two (2) years, commencing with the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020 and ending June 30, 2022, for the purpose of financing any lawful expenses of maintaining and operating the District; all as provided in the Resolution adopted by the Board of Trustees on February 18, 2020?
