
Good Afternoon:

As the Director of the Twin Falls Senior Center, I would like to make this public announcement. It is important at this time, that we stay diligent in working together and addressing the Coronavirus to make sound decisions for ourselves and our Twin Falls Senior Center extended family (congregate members). After careful consider and heartache the Center will be closed for activities and congregate lunches beginning Monday, March 16, 2020 for an undetermined period of time. This action is to protect our most vulnerable population – individuals over the age of 60. The Twin Falls Senior will continue to provide home delivered meals through the Meals on Wheels program as long as we are able to provide staff and volunteers. All non-essential staff members will not be required to come to work at the present time. There is no reason for anyone to panic. However, I do not believe the Senior Center is a place where individuals can socially distance themselves six feet from other individuals due to the number of individuals the Center serves on a daily basis.

At this time, I am working directly with the Commission of Aging, the Office on Aging, South Central Public Health District, and the Idaho Office of Emergency Management, along with City and County Officials.
