Nevada Gaming Revenues and Collections

Win Revenue Summary – December 2018

Nevada’s nonrestricted gaming licensees reported a total “gaming win” of \$999,664,756 for the month of December 2018. This amounts to a 4.11% increase compared to December 2017, when licensees reported a gaming win of \$960,233,574. For the fiscal year (July 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018), gaming win has increased 1.80%.

Percentage Fee Collections for the Month of January 2019

The State collected \$48,803,331 in percentage fees during the month of January 2019*, based upon the taxable revenues generated in December 2018. This represents a 45.58% (or \$15,279,121) increase compared to the prior year's January, when percentage fee collections were \$33,524,210.
