Dear Judge Du,

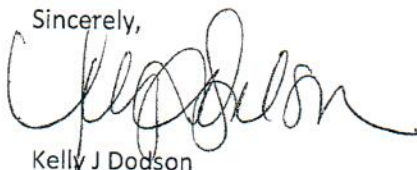
My name is Kelly Dodson, and I am the ex-wife of the above named defendant. I am writing to you out of grave concern for his well-being.

I am extremely worried about the mental and physical state of Mr. West. I realize he is in the state's custody because he has been charged with a crime(s), however I feel the treatment he has been receiving while in county care has been inadequate to his current medical situation. Personally I have no information or knowledge of the alleged activities which resulted in his arrest, but I do have first-hand knowledge of his medical background and the level of pain he endured for years. I believe his pain management has been mishandled, and he has unfortunately fallen into abusing prescribed pain medication. While I am in no way excusing poor decisions he may have made, I am stating he has an addiction problem which needs to be addressed by rehabilitation specialists in a rehabilitation/medical facility. I do not feel jail is the answer, and is only attributing to his demise.

It has come to my attention that Mr. West has lost a significant amount of weight since the time of his arrest, and is in a dire physical and mental state. With the highest respect for you and your well-deserved position, I am pleading with you to grant Mr. West bail, and please release him into a medical/rehabilitation facility. Thousands of people in America struggle with addiction, and while I cannot personally understand it, I can certainly empathize. I have previously written a letter on his behalf requesting he be released into the care of his parents, but seeing as the circumstance has become more serious, I am now requesting he receive medical attention. I am not asking he be exonerated from any wrong-doings he may have participated in, but I am asking he be treated in a humane and fair manner. I firmly believe in our country's "innocent until proven guilty" mantra; he has yet to receive a fair trial, yet I feel he has already been convicted by being denied the necessary medical care he so obviously needs. I fear for his life.
