INDICTMENT

The Federal Grand Jury charges:

COUNT ONE

**FELON IN POSSESSION OF FIREARM & AMMUNITION**  
[18 U.S.C. §§ 922(g)(1) & 924(a)(2)]

On or about December 28, 2016, within the Eastern District of Oklahoma, the defendant, **AARON PAUL VICTORY**, having been convicted of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, did knowingly possess in and affecting commerce, a firearm and ammunition, to-wit:

- One (1) Smith & Wesson, Model SD40VE, .40 S&W caliber pistol, serial number: FWH9226;
- Ten (10) rounds of Winchester brand .40 S&W caliber ammunition; and
- Three (3) rounds of Hornady brand .40 S&W caliber ammunition,

which had been shipped and transported in interstate commerce, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(2).

**COUNT TWO**

**POSSESSION OF STOLEN FIREARM  
[18 U.S.C. §§ 922(j) & 924(a)(2)]**


On or about December 28, 2016, within the Eastern District of Oklahoma, the defendant, **AARON PAUL VICTORY**, did knowingly possess a stolen firearm, to-wit: One (1) Smith & Wesson, Model SD40VE, .40 S&W caliber pistol, serial number: FWH9226, which had been shipped and transported in interstate commerce, knowing and having reasonable cause to believe that the firearm was stolen, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(j) and 924(a)(2).
