2 something that they know about, first of all?

3 MR. ROBERTSON: They do know about this, Your
4 Honor.

5 THE COURT: And are they comfortable with the
6 plea?

7 MR. ROBERTSON: Well, they were comfortable with
8 the plea based upon the assertions that have been made
9 that Mr. Petty would, in fact, plead guilty to the three
10 felonies and admit that he had committed --

11 THE COURT: Well, they are or they're not. Are
12 they?

13 MR. ROBERTSON: I'm sorry?

14 THE COURT: They either are or are not.

15 MR. ROBERTSON: Yes, Your Honor.

16 THE COURT: They are?

17 MR. ROBERTSON: Yes.

18 THE COURT: Okay. Do you have anything else you
19 want me to know before I announce my sentence?

20 MR. ROBERTSON: No, Your Honor.

21 THE COURT: Okay. Do you feel like you've had
22 an opportunity to be heard sufficiently?

23 MR. ROBERTSON: I do, Your Honor.

24 THE COURT: All right. The Court makes those
