

Now comes, Melinda McElroy, a deputy with the Lawrence County Sheriff's Office, being duly sworn and on my oath does state and affirm as follows:

During the years of 2010-2013, Gene Godwin committed the crime of stealing from the Buck Prairie Special Road District.

The office of Missouri State Auditor completed an audit on the Buck Prairie Special Road District after a complaint was filed with the Sheriff's Office 10/09/14 regarding stealing.

The audit showed Gene Godwin received the following check's; 02/16/10 \$960.00, 02/28/11 \$480.00, 03/26/12 \$520.00, 04/29/13 \$520.00, 12/30/13 \$480.00 totaling \$2960.00. These payments for meeting attendance violate state law.

The secretary/treasurer paid each commissioner \$40.00 for each monthly. Former board commissioner initially indicated these payments were for attending meeting but later indicated the payments may have been for mileage but no documentation was located for mileage reimbursement.

The audit further disclosed that Gene Godwin had Buck Prairie Special Road District pave two private roads. One of the private roads, private road 1242, belonged to Godwin who paid \$2700 which was later determined Godwin should have paid \$3000 for the paving. The second private road, 1241 was also paved at a cost of \$1300 which was less than the county bid documents.

Blevins Asphalt was requested to complete a bid for private road 1241 and 1242 for the completion year of 2012 and the bid for these roads were listed on the quote to be \$12,942.08 or \$13,6768.08 depending on type of oil used.

The facts and information contained herein are true and correct. All statements made herein are true with the knowledge that false statements and declarations are punishable under the law.

Affiant asks the Prosecuting Attorney of Lawrence County to consider the above facts for determination of probable cause to charge Gene Wesley Godwin, DOB [REDACTED], SSN/[REDACTED] with Stealing.

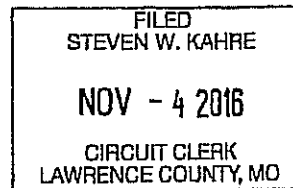

Now comes, Melinda McElroy, a deputy with the Lawrence County Sheriff's Office, being duly sworn and on my oath does state and affirm as follows:

During the years of 2013-2014, Scott Killman committed the crime of stealing from the Buck Prairie Special Road District.

The office of Missouri State Auditor completed an audit on the Buck Prairie Special Road District after a complaint was filed with the Sheriff's Office 10/09/14 regarding stealing.

The audit showed Blaine Morris was paid over 135 hours of vacation in both 2014 and 2013, Austin Morris was paid for 110 hours of vacation in 2014 and Scott Killman was paid for over 110 hours of vacation in both 2014 and 2013.

I checked the payroll records provided to me from the auditor and the following is the breakdown of the vacation hours for 2013 and 2014.

2014

Blaine Morris 140 hours
Austin Morris 112 hours
Scott Killman 128 hours

Each employee received 80 hours of vacation per year so there was an overpayment of 140 hours for the year of 2014.

Blaine Morris was over paid for 60 hours at a rate of \$16.64 totaling \$998.40.

Austin Morris was over paid for 32 hours at a rate of \$14.35 totaling \$459.20.

Scott Killman was over paid for 48 hours at a rate of \$14.35 totaling \$688.80.

Total payout for 2014 was \$2146.40

2013

Blaine Morris 136 hours
Austin Morris 68 hours
Scott Killman 124 hours

Each employee received 80 hours of vacation per year so there was an over payment of 88 hours for the year of 2013.

Blaine Morris was over paid for 56 hours at a rate of ~~\$16.00~~ totaling ~~\$896.00~~.

Scott Killman was over paid for 44 hours at a rate of \$13.80 totaling \$607.20.

Total payout for 2013 was \$1503.20


During the week ending 12/20/13 Scott Killman was paid for 107 hours of overtime along with 80 hours of regular pay which appeared to be excessive during the two week period. The total amount of gross pay for these hours was \$2225.25.

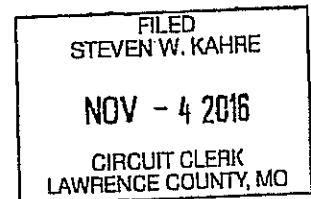
On 10/05/16 I spoke with Heather Davis regarding the procedure for pay checks at Buck Prairie Road Dist. Davis advised she would receive a phone call or text message from Blaine regarding the hours worked for the pay period. Davis stated Blaine would tell her how many hours were regular pay and if there was any sick time or vacation time used. Davis stated Blaine called in the hours 90% of the time, when he was on vacation the other employees would call their times in.

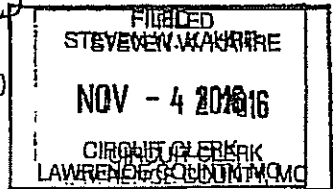



Now comes, Melinda McElroy, a deputy with the Lawrence County Sheriff's Office, being duly sworn and on my oath does state and affirm as follows:

The office of Missouri State Auditor completed an audit on the Buck Prairie Special Road District after a complaint was filed with the Sheriff's Office 10/09/14 regarding stealing.

During the audit several payments were made to Blaine Morris and his business Broken-B-Farms for hauling dirt and rock without soliciting bids and repairs during the years of 2010-2014. On 07/09/10, \$4015.00, 07/27/10, \$3960.00, 06/28/12, \$1300.00, 01/09/13, \$5418.00, 08/07/13, \$1458.00, repair's \$1525.00, 08/30/13, \$358.00, 04/17/14, \$1911.00, repair's, \$200.00, 05/23/14, \$720.00 totaling \$20,865.00 for hauling and repairs. The audit showed there was no documentation for repairs made for the payments in 2013 and 2014. There was also no documentation in the form of meeting minutes approving the use of Blaine Morris personal business to haul dirt for the Buck Prairie Special Road District.

There were additional payments made to Blaine Morris during 2010-2014 for repairs that there was no or very little documentation of such repairs. Blaine Morris received sixteen separate checks between 2010-2014 totaling \$4484.00 for repairs.

It was also discovered that Blaine Morris was overpaid \$200.00 for cell phone use, \$100.00 in 2013 and \$100.00 in November 2014 after he was terminated from Buck Prairie Road District.

Blaine Morris purchased two tires from Sawyer tire for his personal loader for \$655.00 and charged them to Buck Prairie Road District. Blaine Morris provided a receipt where he paid cash for the tires on November 3, 2014 after being questioned about the purchase during his interview with me at the Sheriff's office.

Blaine Morris also purchased a rake wheel, \$100.00 and jumper cables, 83.00 from S&H supply. The rake wheel was for Morris personal use and he advised he paid for the items. Total payout for 2013 was \$1503.20

The audit also showed that for the week ending December 6, 2013 Blaine, Austin and Scott were paid for 35 hours of overtime on top of their regular pay of 40 hours, 16 hours of holiday pay and then 24 hours of vacation time. There were no time sheets or leave records to show when this 35 hours was worked during that two week pay period totaling \$2289.00.

Also, during the week ending 12/20/13 Blaine Morris was paid for 111.50 hours of overtime along with 80 hours of regular pay which appeared to be excessive during the two week period. The total amount of gross pay for these hours was \$2676.00.

On 10/05/16 I spoke with Heather Davis regarding the procedure for pay checks at Buck Prairie Road Dist. Davis advised she would receive a phone call or text message from Blaine regarding the hours worked for the pay period. Davis stated Blaine would tell her how many hours were regular pay and if there was any sick time or vacation time used. Davis stated Blaine called in the hours 90% of the time, when he was on vacation the other employees would call their times in.
