Whereas, beginning on April 19, 2018 at 10:00 am,

Exist to State Road Ways in Preston County, West Virginia.

Whereas, the effects of disrepair have caused severe damage to state roads and pose a threat to the health, safety, welfare and property of the citizens of Preston County.

Now Therefore, be it resolved that I, Craig Jennings, President of the Preston County Commission, under the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this State and Governor Justice and in recognition of the gravity of the situation, do hereby find and declare a State of Emergency to exist in Preston County.

Now Therefore, this State of Emergency shall exist for 365 days unless extended.

Done at the Preston County Office of Emergency Management, this the 19th day of April, in the year of the Lord, Two Thousand Eighteen and in the One Hundred Fifty Forth year of the State.
