Beginning July 8, 2016, Hombre Golf Club will suspend play on the Bad 9 holes to allow course re-routing of holes #1 and #2. This advancement follows tremendous improvements made in 2015 to the Bad 9 greens, renovations to the clubhouse, along with current improvements being made to the Ugly 9 greens. Funds generated from this endeavor will enable us to continue making state-of-the-art improvements throughout the facility.

The Ugly 9 greens renovations are moving along nicely, and are expected to be ready for play sometime in late August. The member statement you will receive in July lists your June dues as well as any charges and fees occurred in June. As Hombre transitions to a 9-hole facility beginning July 8th until the 18-hole facility (Good/Ugly) reopens, all membership dues will be suspended. During this period members may still continue to utilize the practice facility or elect to play the Good 9 holes for cart fee only. Trail members may elect to continue paying trail fees for unlimited play on the Good 9, or choose to pay a cart fee upon check-in at the Golf Shop. The Siesta Grill will remain open as business levels dictate.

With a 30-year history, Hombre is prepared to move forward to become a superior, brand new golf course. We are committed to creating the best golf experience Hombre Golf Club has ever had, and the new golf course will bring with it opportunities for restructured membership and a positive momentum moving forward.
