COMPLAINT FOR CUSTODY OF MINOR CHILD

COMES NOW Plaintiff Dakota L. Meyer ("Meyer"), by and through his counsel of record, and hereby files his Complaint for Custody of Minor Child and requests that he be granted joint legal and shared physical custody of the minor child. In support of his request, Meyer shows the court as follows:

1. Meyer is a resident of Greensburg, Kentucky.
2. Bristol Palin ("Palin") is a resident of Wasilla, Alaska.
3. Palin is the biological mother of Sailor Grace Palin, DOB 12/23/15.
4. Meyer and Palin had a relationship and were engaged to be married until May, 2015. Meyer believes that he is the biological father of the minor child.
5. Sailor Grace Palin has lived in Alaska since her birth on December 23, 2015 and continues to reside with Palin in Wasilla, Alaska.

6. The court has jurisdiction of this matter and venue in this court is proper.
7. No custody order involving the child has been issued in Alaska or in any other state.
8. Meyer and Palin have never been married.
9. It is in Sailor Grace Palin's best interest for the biological parents to share joint legal custody of the child.
10. It is in Sailor Grace Palin's best interest for the biological parents to have shared physical custody.
11. Child support should be ordered in accordance with Alaska Civil Rule 90.3.
12. Each parent should be permitted to claim the minor child as a dependent for income tax purposes on alternating years.

WEREFORE PLAINTIFF SEEKS THE FOLLOWING RELIEF:

- a. A decree of joint legal custody and shared physical custody of Sailor Grace Palin;
- b. That child support be awarded in accordance with Rule 90.3; and
- c. Such other and further relief as the court deems appropriate in the circumstances.
