NOTICE OF TORT CLAIM

Dear Clerk:

Notice is hereby given of the Tort Claim of pursuant to the Political Subdivision Tort Claims Act, Neb. Rev. Stat. § 13-905 et seq. (Reissue 1998).

The Complainant was incarcerated at Douglas County Corrections between approximately June 7, 2016 and November 4, 2016.

Since the date of his incarceration, the Complainant repeatedly complained of pain and other symptoms of a Sexually Transmitted Infection. Despite repeated complaints on the part of the Complainant to at least three separate nurses and/or medical assistants who were agents of Douglas County, his pleas for medical treatment were ignored by those charged with providing him medical treatment, causing him further pain and health complications for approximately five months. The Complainant was later diagnosed with Chlamydia by health care providers at the Diagnostic and Evaluation Center after he was transferred away from Douglas County Corrections.

The Complainant complained of his symptoms to nurses with Douglas County

Corrections, and stated that he believed that he had contracted Chlamydia. These symptoms

included painful urination, inflamation, itching, burning, and tenderness. The Complainant stated
that he had contracted Chlamydia on a previous occasion and had experienced similar symptoms.

had contracted Chlamydia, the nurse advised him to "drink lots of water." The nurse negligently failed to test the Complainant for Chlamydia and instead recommended treatment which enhanced the Complainant's discomfort. The Complainant may incur medical expenses in the future as a result of his negligent treatment, has suffered severe pain, continues to suffer from painful urination, and may suffer from disability relating to his prolonged period of infection.

Douglas County Department of Corrections failed to provide proper medical treatment, and the negligent, improper, and incomplete treatment which the Complainant has received is the
