## **New South Omaha Testing Hours for DCHD Drive-Thru Clinic**

There is a change in the schedule for the Douglas County Health Department's drive-thru COVID-19 testing clinic for Thursday and Friday, May 21 and May 22.

For those two days, testing will begin at noon and continue until 5 p.m. or all the tests have been used. The clinic is not scheduled to be open during the weekend or on Monday, the Memorial Day holiday.

"This is an example of the Health Department listening to the community and responding," Health Director Dr. Adi Pour said. "We feel this will help us increase our testing numbers."

DCHD and the Nebraska National Guard will continue to host the clinic at the same site in the parking lot across from the South Omaha location of OneWorld Community Health Center, 4920 South 30<sup>th</sup> Street.

COVID-19 symptoms may include, but are not limited to, a fever, cough, sore throat, severe fatigue, or difficulty breathing. In most cases, a person will have more than one symptom. If you have COVID-19 symptoms, please contact your health care provider before you go to their office and tell them how you are feeling, and discuss any possible exposure history.
