A Bike Giveaway Program for Underprivileged Children in the Fremont Area

About the Program

Wishing Wheels is an annual holiday bicycle giveaway for underprivileged children that is sponsored by the Fremont Cycling Group. Fremont area children ages 4 to 16 are eligible for the drawing. Each holiday season, members of the Cycling Group collaborate with local organizations like the Salvation Army, Care Corps Homeless Shelter, the Masonic Home for Children and Jefferson House to identify underprivileged youth in need of bikes and bike equipment such as helmets and locks. Each winner receives a bike, helmet and a lock, and has his/her bike registered with the Fremont Police Department. Each bike package costs approximately \$150 and to date more than 300 area youth have benefitted from the giveaway.
