### Press Release

On Thursday April 11, 2018 Officers from the Wisconsin Rapids Police Department were called to a disturbance in the 100 block of Oak Brook Ct. Responding Officers found a male subject with a wound to his lower leg.

Investigating Officers learned that a male and female live in the residence together, and had been arguing. During the argument the female brought three knives to the bedroom area where the male was attempting to sleep. The male subject grabbed the knives out of the hand of the female subject and threw them to the floor. Unknown to the victim, one of the knives fell into his pants on the floor. The male subject did not see the knife, and went to his pants and boots on. The knife in the pants cut an artery in his leg, resulting in a large amount of blood loss. The Wisconsin Rapids Fire Department transported the male to Aspirus Riverview where he was treated and later released.

The female subject was arrested for endangering safety by use of a dangerous weapon. Her actions caused a safety issue by bringing knives into an argument. She was transported to the Wood County Jail and later posted bond.
