FISHER**, on or between the 1ST day of JANUARY, 2016 through the 1ST day of OCTOBER, 2018, in Lucas County, Ohio, did knowingly touch the genitalia of another, when the touching was not through clothing, the other person was less than twelve (12) years of age, whether or not the offender knew the age of that person, and the touching was done with an intent to abuse, humiliate, harass, degrade, or arouse or gratify the sexual desire of any person, in violation of **§2907.05 (B) and (C)(2) OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE, GROSS SEXUAL IMPOSITION, BEING A FELONY OF THE THIRD DEGREE**, contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.



NOTICE TO DEFENDANT

§2929.14(A)(3)(a) For a felony of the third degree that is a violation of section 2903.06, 2903.08, 2907.03, 2907.04 or 2907.05 of the Revised Code or that is a violation of section 2911.02 or 2911.12 of the Revised Code if the offender previously has been convicted of or pleaded guilty in two or more separate proceedings to two or more violations of section 2911.01, 2911.02, 2911.11

or 2911.12 of the Revised Code, the prison term shall be twelve, eighteen, twenty-four, thirty, thirty-six, forty-two, forty-eight, fifty-four or sixty months.

§2929.14(A)(3)(b) For a felony of the third degree that is not an offense for which division (A)(3)(a) of this section applies, the prison term shall be nine, twelve, eighteen, twenty-four, thirty, or thirty-six months.
