Officer Breeze:

I have reviewed the recent Memorandum from Chief George Kral dated June 25, 2019 regarding discipline charges brought against you by the Department for case #8035. Specifically, you were charged with:

- 1. Violation of Department Directive 103.3/5.16.8 "Abuse of Authority,"
- 2. Violation of Department Directive 103.3/5.16.2 "Neglect of Duty," and
- 3. Violation of Department Directive 103.3/5.14.2 "Demeanor"

A hearing was held before Chief Kral regarding the above charges. Based on the information presented at the hearing, Chief Kral found you guilty. Chief Kral assessed the following penalty for the charges:

- In total, you are assessed a twenty-eight (28) workday suspension. You will be required to serve a ten (10) workday suspension, without pay, and the remaining eighteen (18) workdays, without pay, will be held in abeyance for three (3) years.
- The terms and conditions of the agreement shall be in place for period of three (3) years.
- You waived all rights to appeal, grieve or otherwise contest any stipulations of this agreement.

Please be advised that I concur with the recommendation of Chief Kral. You should recognize the serious nature of your actions and understand that it is your responsibility to make sure that similar infractions do not occur in the future. Similar actions on your part shall result in more severe discipline up to and including termination.

By copy of this letter, I am directing the Chief of Police to impose the suspension and terms of the above referenced agreement.
